NAMING OPPORTUNITY UPDATE: This weekend during Hospitality, the Capital Campaign will recognize the first six of our parishioners who have fulfilled their pledges. The items that have been named so far include the ambo (pulpit), the baptistery (Baptismal font), the reception area, one of three votive candle holders, and three pews. Many items are still available at various naming levels and there is never a "missed date" to submit a pledge.

DONOR RECOGNITION PLAQUE: The committee is researching various plaques that reflect the best way to identify our donors and the naming level. We hope to have an example of how each donor is recognized within the church building at future Hospitality events and then permanent display at our Make a Joyful Noise table in our current church's vestibule.



GRASSROOTS EFFORTS: As you watch the "Church Tote Board" in the vestibule to see where we are in terms of pledges, what you may not see on is where the community effort stands - - what we have termed, "Grassroots" so named because even if you are unable to provide a pledge, the Grassroots efforts reflect occasional dollar that is spent. Examples of these efforts are things like the Joyful Bakers, the 50/50 Raffle, the Fish Fry, and the soon to be published Taste & See Cookbook. Since October 2007, the results of these efforts have yielded \$3,580 toward our overall goal of reaching \$400,000. We have a long way to go which is why it is so important that all parishioners support as many of the Grassroots efforts as possible.

Question: What is the minimum pledge amount to select a naming opportunity?

Answer: To name a specific element, a \$10,000 pledge is needed. Fulfilled pledges in the amounts of \$1,000 to \$9,999 will receive recognition on a plaque but no specific item will be named.
