Artist Rendering – The Building Committee and Capital Campaign Sub-Committee are working closely with the architect to provide a comprehensive view of the grounds with the new church structure. The preliminary plans were used to create the first version of the building. Those of you who have gone through the building process for a new home know that the first attempts do not always result in the finished product. The Building Committee Chair is working to fine tune the requirements for the architect to incorporate into the final plans. We are getting closer to being able to provide the community with this view.

Diocesan Approval – Once the final plans are prepared, the Building and Finance Committee chairs will meet with Fr. Gary and Bishop Baker to obtain the Diocese's stamp of approval. With that in place, site work will begin very shortly on the church property.
